## FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH SCHOLARSHIP 2024

First Christian Church of Wellington, Kansas

The following policies and provisions will govern the awarding of scholarships:

- 1. Scholarships may be awarded to any **member** of First Christian Church and/or to those **non-members who have been attending and actively involved in church activities** including Sunday School, Worship Service, regular participation in Youth Group. Applicants who are living away from Wellington while in college should share how they have been involved in a church or student ministry away from home.
- 2. The Applicant must be a graduate of an accredited high school or presently in college.
- 3. The Applicant must have completed all requirements for admission to an accredited college, technical school, university, seminary, or school of nursing in the United States.
- 4. The selection of a candidate for a scholarship and the amount awarded to each candidate will be based on the
  - following criteria: need, recommendation letters and personal essay, good moral character; leadership qualities; scholastic records; seriousness of purpose, but not necessarily in the order listed.
- 5. Scholarships will be awarded for one year; however, a recipient will be eligible to reapply each year.
- 6. The availability of funds may determine the number and the amounts of scholarships awarded each year.
- 7. Scholarships are to be considered an outright gift to the recipient with no requirement for repayment.
- 8. Application for scholarships must be turned in by May 1st in the year in which the student is to enter school. No exceptions will be made to this deadline.
- 9. Applicants must use the proper Application Form and complete each line.
- 10. Applicants must submit two up-to-date letters of recommendation. One letter from a teacher and the other letter from a non-relative. Recommendations are to come from individuals that the applicant has been involved with during the present school year. Exceptions will be made for online students regarding letter from teacher.
- 11. Applicant must submit an essay on how the scholarship will assist in his/her education with the application.
- 12. The most current transcript of the applicant's academic record is required with the Application.
- 13. Scholarships will be awarded by the Committee and presented to the recipients during a Sunday morning worship service.
- 14. These policies and provisions may be amended by the Church Board.
- 15. The Scholarship Committee may recommend amendments to the Church Board.
